

- CMYK
- Spot Colour
- White Layer

NOTE: Image can extend into the transparent area however, unless there is base ink down first (such as white) there will be a noticeable color difference between the opaque area and transparent area.

White is considered the 5th color in a full color print job. Full color print jobs must be saved in CMYK - unless the art was designed with Spot Colors.

If White is to be used as the fifth color, a solid layer must be provided for film output (100% black)

If White is not used, the silver of the CD will show through, acting as the white layer. This can be a very effective design element.
